RT just completed solo dates in UK, Ireland, and Germany (July) and UK Band tour (August) which included performances at Fairport Convention's 40th Anniversary at Cropredy. Audiences were treated to songs from the recent brilliant album, Sweet Warrior, along with old favourites.
